## Thank you for using our Patient Portal !

As part of a government mandate to improve health care efficiency, we provide a secure Patient Portal. This provides you secure access to your health care records and also provides a means to communicate with your physician via secure email. Routine email messages to your physician can no longer be made. All communication should be through the Portal.

### To use our portal:

1. Go to [camillamccalmont.com](http://camillamccalmont.com) in your browser. Firefox is recommended.
2. Click on the PatientPortal icon on the right (below the telephone number)
3. Login using your user name and password. Your user name follows the formula **lastnameMMDD**, with MM and DD representing your birthdate with no zeroes included. For example, the username for John Doe born on March 14 is **doe314**

**USERNAME: lastnameMMDD** (see above; no zeroes)

**TEMPORARY PASSWORD (PW):** (supplied by office; call if you do not have)

**Once you have logged in** with your temporary PW, please change the PW to something of your own choosing. A PW with at least 7 characters is required.

**To contact the office or your doctor**, go to the top left hand corner of the web page and use the "contact us" tab.

## ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

- **CONTACT INFORMATION AND INSURANCE TABS:** please review and verify information
- **PHARMACY TAB:** done in the office
- **PAST MEDICAL HISTORY TAB:** allows you to add any conditions that apply to your health
- **SKIN DISEASE HISTORY TAB:** allows you to add any history of previous skin disorders
- **MEDICATIONS TAB:** allows you to add any current prescription and OTC medications
- **ALLERGIES TAB:** allows you to add any known drug allergies
- **SOCIAL HISTORY TAB:** allows you to add any history of smoking or alcohol use
- **PROBLEM LIST TAB:** allows you to view previous diagnoses made by your doctor.
- **TESTS AND RESULTS TAB:** allows you to view any ordered tests and the results.
